

FIELD of GLORY Army Lists Book3 – README June 2023:

In order to ensure complete compatibility between players using the latest downloadable lists and those using the Version 3 Printed version (along with the errata and supplemental lists), the following minor changes (in grey) have been made to the previous copy of FOGAM_Book3_Mar2023.

Anyone with a printed copy of these lists will need to replace the pages listed below.

Alternatively, players should instead use the latest copy of the rules: FOGAM_v3.1_book3_ArmyLists_June2023.

Page 6: "Koryo Korean": "**Hang-ma-gun**"/Armour Replace "~~Unprotected~~" with "**Protected**" and replace "5" points per base with "**6**"

Page 7: "Koryo Korean Allies": "**Hang-ma-gun**"/Armour Replace "~~Unprotected~~" with "**Protected**" and replace "5" points per base with "**6**"

Page 10: "Taifa Andalusian": "**Andalusian Spearmen**" + "**archers**"/Total Bases, Replace "~~24-32~~" with "**24-72**"

Page 12: "Medieval Spanish and Portuguese": "**Spearmen**": "Bases per BG" Replace "~~4-6~~" with "**6-8**", Total Bases – Replace "~~0-12~~" with "**0-32**"

Page 36: "Medieval Welsh": "**Welsh knights**"/Heavily Armoured/Bases per BG Replace "~~3-4~~" with "**4**" (merge with entry below).

Page 38: "Medieval Burmese" DELETE the 2nd and 5th bullet points and ADD a new bullet point as follows:

- Burmese ally-commanders' contingents must conform to the Medieval Burmese Allies list below, but the troops in the contingent are deducted from the minima and maxima in the main list.

ADD an allied general as follows:

Page 39: "Medieval Burmese Allies" "**Pagan or Burman spearmen**" Replace the Bottom entry (undrilled troops only) with the following:

Page 60: "Teutonic Knights Allies": "**Mercenary men-at-arms**"/Total Bases – Replace "~~3-8~~" with "**4-8**"

Page 64: "Yuan Chinese Allies": "**Guard cavalry**"/Bases per BG & Total Bases: Replace "~~4-6~~" and "~~0-6~~" with "**4**" and "**0-4**"

Page 69: "Swiss": "**Pikemen**" – From 1422AD Total Bases - Replace "~~24-48~~" with "**12-40**" and "~~0-36~~" with "**12-40**"
"Crossbowmen" & "**Handgunners**"/Total Bases - Replace "~~6-24~~" with "**12-24**"

Page 79: "Medieval Scandinavian": INSERT above "Fortified camp": Field defences/3 pts per base 0-8

Page 80: "Medieval Scandinavian Allies": "**Swedish**"/Shooting ADD "**Longbow**" as an alternative to crossbow @ 11pts per base.

Page 81: "Catalan company": **Alan Allies** – REPLACE "~~Book1: Alan Allies~~" with "**Book2: Early Alan list**"

Page 88: "Later Plantagenet and Early Tudor English (Britain)": "**Combined battlegroups**" Replace "~~*0-30~~" with "***0-36**"

Page 89: "Ming Chinese": "**Mongol or Jurchen cavalry**"/Point per Bases: Replace "~~12/11/10~~" with "**19/15/13**" (top to bottom).
"Chinese archers"/Total bases – Replace "~~6-30~~" with "**16-30**"

Page 97: "Tupl": Territory Types: - ADD "Hilly"

Troop commander: DELETE "~~0-3~~" MERGE both entries into one "**0-2**". ADD Allied commander as follows:

Page 101: "Inca": "**Anti or Chuncho guardsmen**" - Bases per BG/Total Bases Replace "~~6~~" with "**6-8**" and "~~0-6~~" with "**0-8**"

Page 105: "Ordonnance French": "**Ordonnance men-at-arms**"/average/Total Bases Replace "~~6-20~~" with "**6-12**"
