GLOBAL CHANGES

- All superior and elite heavy chariots have their "Bases per BG entry changed to "3-4"
- All scythed chariots have their "Bases per BG" entry changed to "2, 3 or 4"

Page 5: "Carthaginian" should be "[Later Carthaginian](#)"
RH column ADD "[Mannaeen Allies](#)" below "Kyrenean Greek allies"

Page 7: BATTLE GROUPS – Bullet 2.2 INSERT "[heavy chariots, scythed chariots](#)" after "elephants"

Page 24: "Hittite Empire" – "Syro-Canaanite chariots" – "Points per Base", Replace "~~14~~" with "13"

Page 28: "TABLE "LATER HEBREW" – Allies, last entry – REPLACE "Philistine and" with "[Philistine and/or](#)".

Page 29: "TABLE "LATER HEBREW ALLIES" Chariots – Split the "Points per base" into 2 for both light and heavy chariots. Superior light chariots should be [19 pts](#) and superior heavy chariots should be [24 pts](#)

Page 30: TABLE "LYBIAN EGYPTIAN" - "Egyptian close fighters" & "Egyptian archers" UPGRADE both from "~~Poor~~" to "[Average](#)" and change "Points per Base" to "7" and "6" respectively.

Page 33: "KIMMERIAN, SKYTHIAN OR SAKA" RH Column, 1st line REPLACE "~~Antigones V11~~" with "[Antiochos VII](#)"

Page 34: TABLE "KIMMERIAN, SKYTHIAN OR SAKA" –
➤ "Armoured cavalry" – After "Only Kimmerians from 630 BC" ADD "[and Skythians before 550 BC](#)"
➤ "Armoured cavalry" – "Any except Kimmerians..." REPLACE "~~630 BC~~" with "[550 BC](#)"
➤ NB. Same changes should be made in the ALLIES list.
➤ "Less armoured cavalry"/Total Bases – should be "[10-32](#)" for Light Horse and "[10-32](#)" for Cavalry (same split as in the Allies list).

Page 35: TABLE "KIMMERIAN, SKYTHIAN OR SAKA ALLIES"
➤ Allies – Only Kimmerian, ADD "[Mannaeen allies - see Supplemental List1 - Mannaen Allies](#)"
➤ Allies – Replace "Only Skythians...etc" with "[Any except Kimmerians from 550BC to 301BC](#)"

Page 38: 6th Bullet After "dismount as Superior" INSERT "[or Average \(as mounted type\)](#)"

Page 45: TABLE "NEO-ASSYRIAN ALLIES" Chariots "points per base" REPLACE "~~17~~" with "24"

Page 47: "THRACIAN", Add a bullet point:

- [A Thracian ally general's contingent must conform to the Thracian Allies list below, but the troops in the contingent are deducted from the minima and maxima in the main list.](#)

Page 48: TABLE "THRACIAN"
➤ Thracian allied commander "1-3" CHANGE to: "1-3 ([None for Getae](#))"
➤ Veteran cavalry/armour – CHANGE to "[Noble](#) cavalry" and REPLACE "~~Protected~~" with "[armoured](#)"
➤ SPECIAL CAMPAIGNS - Roman client kingdom - REPLACE "~~46 BC~~" with "[46 AD](#)"

Page 52: "CLASSICAL GREECE"
➤ 2nd bullet – INSERT "[or Allied Commander](#)" after "C-in-C".
➤ 6th Bullet: ADD at the end: "[Treat them as 'average' for all tests until their true identity is disclosed.](#)"

Page 53: TABLE "CLASSICAL GREEK (CONTINUED)" Thureophoroi – REPLACE "Only from ~~27 BC~~" with "only from [279 BC](#)".

Page 61: TABLE "EARLY ACHAEMENID PERSIAN"
➤ Saka Cavalry - "Bases per BG" REPLACE "~~6-8~~" with "[4-6](#)"
➤ "Optional Troops" INSERT new entry as below:

- Arab Camelry/Type – after "Camelry" ADD "[or Light Camelry](#)"

Page 65: TABLE "EARLY CARTHAGINIAN" Numidian light cavalry - "Total bases" - REPLACE "~~0-6~~" with "[4-8](#)"

Page 72: TABLE "LATER ACHAEMENID PERSIAN"

- Guard Infantry ("Apple bearers") – REPLACE "~~Protected~~" with "Armoured" (twice). "Points per Base" For Elites CHANGE "~~12~~" to "15", for Superiors" CHANGE "~~10~~" to "13". Also – CHANGE "Bases per BG" for Elite to "0-6", for superiors to "4-8" and overall Total Bases from "~~0-6~~" to "0-8"
- > "Massed Levies" should be "Poor"
- > "Scythed Chariots" should be "Average"

ADD "Allies" - Lycian (Lykian) allies (before 546BC) – Lydian or Lycian list

- > Special campaign: Only Darius III at Guagamela in 331 B, Entry: "Cannot use Egyptians, Thracians, or Lykian allies, nor more than ..." DELETE "~~Egyptians, Thracians, or Lykian allies, nor~~" and INSERT "At least 1 battle group each of" before "Guard".

Page 77: "GALLIC AND GALATION" After 1st paragraph (before "Troop Notes" ADD:

Armies must be designated as "Gallic Hill Tribes", "Gallic Lowland Tribes" or "Galation".

TABLE "GALLIC AND GALATION" - Chariots/Galatians: INSERT "16" in "Points per Base"

Page 80: "ALEXANDRIAN MACEDONIAN" Bullet 5: DELETE entire bullet.

Page 81 TABLE – Add the following:

Page 86: TABLE "WARRING STATES TO WESTERN HAN" Territory - ADD "Others - Agricultural, Developed, Hilly"

PAGES 93 to 97: "EARLY AND MIDDLE REPUBLICAN ROMAN" The following changes are to clarify the wording:

Page 93: "EARLY AND MIDDLE REPUBLICAN ROMAN" DELETE 2nd bullet and replace with:

- Hastati, principes and triarii must be organised as legions: A legion must have 2 battle groups of 4 "Hastati & Principes", 1 battle group of 2 "Triarii", and 1 battlegroup of 4 "Leves or Velites". However, these may be combined as follows:
 - Any 2 identical battlegroups of "Hastati & Principes" may be combined to form a single battlegroup of 8 bases.
 - Any 2 identical battlegroups of "Triarii", may be combined to form a single battlegroup of 4 bases.
 - "Leves or Velites" may be reorganised into battlegroups of 4, 6 or 8.

Bullet 6: "If the Hastati & ... "DELETE "~~downgraded~~"

Bullet 9: "~~Ligurians, thurophoroi, ...~~" DELETE entire bullet

Pages 94 & 95 TABLE "EARLY AND MIDDLE REPUBLICAN ROMAN" ALL entries for "Hastati & Principes" "bases per BG" REPLACE "~~4-8~~" with "4 or 8" in each case (4 times)

Page 96 TABLE "EARLY AND MIDDLE REPUBLICAN ROMAN" each of: Ligurian Foot, Thurophoroi, Elephants - ADD "Only from 201 BC". (Clarification).

Page 97: TABLE "EARLY AND MIDDLE REPUBLICAN ROMAN ALLIES" ALL entries for "Hastati & Principes" "bases per BG" REPLACE "~~4-8~~" with "4 or 8" in each case (3 times)

Page 98: TABLE "EARLY ARMENIAN" – Allies – "Media Atropatene" ADD "– see Median Allies"

Page 102: "SELEUCID" ADD an additional bullet.

- Only one battlegroup of Elite Companions may be used.

Page 104: TABLE "SELEUCID (CONTINUED)" Arab Camelry/Type – after "Camelry" ADD "or Light Camelry"

Page 107: TABLE "PTOLEMAIC" Arab Camelry/Type – after "Camelry" ADD "or Light Camelry" - DELETE the line for "Poor" elephants.

"Javelinmen" should be "Undrilled"

"Arab camelry" should be "Undrilled"

"Elephants" should be "Undrilled"

"Roman Legionaries" should be "Drilled"

"Bolt Shooters" should be "Drilled"

Page 109: TABLE "LATER PRE-ISLAMIC BEDOUIN" Camel riders –REPLACE entries with:

Page 110: TABLE "PYRRHIC ALLIES" – "Archers", "Slingers", Javelinmen" – Total Bases – MERGE entries to a single "6-8"

Page 112: TABLE "LATER CARTHAGINIAN" - Balearic slingers - REPLACE "Protected" with "Unprotected"

Page 113: TABLE "LATER CARTHAGINIAN (CONT.)" – Hannibal in Italy/Upgrade Gallic Foot/Total Bases: REPLACE "All" with "Up to 1/2"
TABLE "LATER CARTHAGINIAN ALLIES" – "Libyphoenician , Gallic or Spanish cavalry" "Close Combat" Replace "Light Swordsmen" with "Light Spear, Swordsmen"

Page 116: TABLE "ATTALID PERGAMENE ALLIES" - CinC - DELETE "Inspired Commander" and CHANGE points per base to "30/20"

Page 120: "PARTHIAN AND EARLY SASSANID PERSIAN" - "Cataphracts" ADD a line below as follows:

Page 123: TABLE "ANCIENT SPANISH ALLIES – Caetrati/Type: ADD "or Medium Foot" after "Light Foot"

Page 129: TABLE "LATER JEWISH ALLIES" - Upgraded Thureophoroi - protected: REPLACE "0-16" with "0-12"

Page 132: "EARLY GERMAN" "Warriors" "Points per base" Replace "9" with "10" for both superior types.

Page 136: TABLE "Later Republican Roman" Allies ADD a new entry "Later Arab Allies"

Page 140: TABLE "ANCIENT BRITISH AND CALEDONIAN" Allied Commanders: ADD "*" in front of "1-3"

REPLACE "12-24" WITH "8-24"

Camel mounted warrior/Types: after "Camelry" ADD "or Light Camelry"
