

FIELD of GLORY Army Lists Book1 – README July 2023:

In order to ensure complete compatibility between players using the latest downloadable lists and those using the Version 3 Printed version (along with the errata and supplemental lists), the following minor changes (in grey) have been made to the previous copy of FOGAM_Book1_Mar2023.

Anyone with a printed copy of these lists will need to replace the pages listed below.

Alternatively, players should instead use the latest copy of the rules: FOGAM_v3.1_book1_ArmyLists_July2023.

Page 6: "Early Highland Raisers": "**Mesopotamian retained spearmen**": "Points per base" for average and superior are should be swapped. Thy should read from top to bottom: '10', '7', '9', '7'.

Page 10: "Later Sumerian or Akkadian Allies": "**Javelinmen/Average**", "Points per Base", Replace "4" with "5"

Page 14: "Mitanni Allies": "**Archers/Unprotected**": ", "Points per Base", Replace "4" with "5"

Page 21: "Later Mycenaean or Trojan": 2nd bullet: Insert ", or Average (as mounted type)" after "Superior"

ADD 3rd Bullet:

- Achilles's Myrmidons must be under the command of an allied general. If this general is Achilles, he must be an FC

TABLE "Later Mycenaean or Trojan": Special campaigns After "**Only Achaians in the Trojan War**" ADD "(from 1210BC to 1180BC)".

"**Achilles's Myrmidons**": "Points per Base", Replace "12" with "13" and "9" with "10".

TABLE "Later Mycenaean or Trojan": Special campaigns After **Only Trojans in the Trojan War** ADD "(from 1210BC to 1180BC)".

Page 24: "Philistine": "**Elite Spearmen**", Points per Base – Replace "13" with "14" and "10" with "11"

"**Javelinmen/Protected**" "Points per Base" – Replace "5" with "6"

"**Hebrew Mercenaries**", "Points per Base" – Replace "12" with "13" and "9" with "10"

"Philistine Allies": "**Javelinmen/Protected**" "Points per Base" – Replace "5" with "6"

Page 26: "Early Zhou Chinese Allies": "**Spearmen and supporting archers/Offensive Spearmen**", Points per Base – Replace "8" with "10" (x2)

Page 36: "Lydian or Lycian": 2nd Bullet, After "dismount" ADD "as Medium Foot, Armoured or Protected (as Mounted type), superior, Drilled or Undrilled (as mounted type), Light Spear, Swordsmen".

Page 34: TABLE "Kimmerian, Skythian and Saka Allies", "**Armoured cavalry**" Replace "Only Skythians...etc" with "Any except Kimmerians from 550BC to 301BC"

Page 36: 6th Bullet After "dismount as Superior" INSERT "or Average (as mounted type)"

Page 38: "Italian Hill Tribes and Samnite League" "**Hill tribe ally commanders**" Replace "40/25" with "30/20".

Page 39: "Italian Hill Tribes and Samnite League Allies" "**Spearmen**" "Total Bases" Replace "12-32" with "8-24".

Page 42: "Kushite Egyptian" "**Chariots**" "Total Bases" Replace "4-16" with "4-18".

Page 49: "Later Dynastic Egyptian" "**Guard Spearmen**" & "**Guard Archers**" "Total Bases" Replace "6-8" with "4-8". For both.

Page 54: "Early Achaemenid Persian" "Optional Troops" INSERT new entry as below:

Page 58: "Classical Indian": "**Chariots**", "Points per Base", Should read (from top to bottom) "24", "19", "22", "18".

Page 58: "Classical Indian": "**Chariots**", "Points per Base", Should read (from top to bottom) "24", "19", "22", "18".

Page 65: "Gallic and Galation" After 1st paragraph (before "Troop Notes" ADD:

Armies must be designated as "Gallic Hill Tribes", "Gallic Lowland Tribes" or "Galation".

Page 66: "Gallic and Galation Allies" "**Warriors**" – "Total Bases" Replace "12-36" with "8-24".

"**Upgrade Warriors to imitation legionaries**" – "Total Bases" Replace "Up to 24" with "Up to 12".

Page 69: "Alexandrian Macedonian" – "**Foot companions**" – "Total bases" Delete "0-36"

Page 69: "Bosporan" – "**Sindi, Maiotian or other foot archers**" - Medium Foot – "Total Bases" "6-24" Merge with empty cell below.

Page 79: "Early and Mid-Republican Roman" "**Rprarii**", "**Ascensi**", "**Italian allied pedites extraordinarii**", and "**Numidian or Illyrian cavalry**" are NOT included in the "0-12" Total Bases grouping.

Page 80: "Early Armenian" – "Allies" – Replace "**Partian allies**" with: "**Median Atropatene allies – see Median Allies**"

Page 83: "Seleucid" ADD a new bullet: "Only one battlegroup of Elite companions can be used".
 "Archers" and "Slingers" – Total Bases Replace "~~12-18~~" with "6-16"

Page 84: "Seleucid" "Hillmen" & "Thracians" – Total bases Split entry so that each has its own entry of "0-8"
 "Seleucid Allies" "Archers" and "Slingers" – "Total Bases" - Merge all entries to a single entry of "0-8"

Page 85: "Ptolemaic" "Phalangites" & "Thurophoroi" Move from "Optional Troops" to "Core Troops" as below:

Page 90: "Later Carthaginian Allies" – "Libyphoenician , Gallic or Spanish cavalry" "Close Combat" Replace "~~Light Swordsmen~~" with "Light Spear, Swordsmen"

Page 97: "Parthian and Early Sassanid Persian" – ALLIES – ADD "Early Arab Allies"

Page 98: "Ancient Spanish" "Caetrati" - "Shooting" ADD "Javelins", "Close Combat" Delete "Swordsmen" Change "Points per Base" to "5"

Page 99: "Ancient Spanish Allies" "Caetrati" – "Shooting" ADD "Javelins", "Close Combat" Delete "Swordsmen" Change "Points per Base" to "5"

Page 100: "Numidian or Moorish" "Javelinmen" – Light Foot "Total Bases" Replace "~~6-12~~" with "0-8"

Page 105: "Early German" "Javelinmen" – "Total Bases" Replace "~~0-16~~" with "0-12"

Page 109: TABLE "Later Republican Roman" -Allies- ADD a new entry "Later Arab Allies"
